

The PARTIAL Trial: A randomised trial of the clinical and cost effectiveness of complex PARTIAL vs radical nephrectomy for clinically localised renal cell carcinoma

A message from the Chief Investigators

There has been a flurry of recruitment activity at the start of October and it's on track to be the best recruitment month for PARTIAL. Three additional sites have recruited their first participants which means 25 (of 32 sites) have now successfully recruited. By popular request we have also produced bite size recruitment videos (video links below), with examples of how to address common recruitment barriers such as randomisation and patient preference for treatment.
